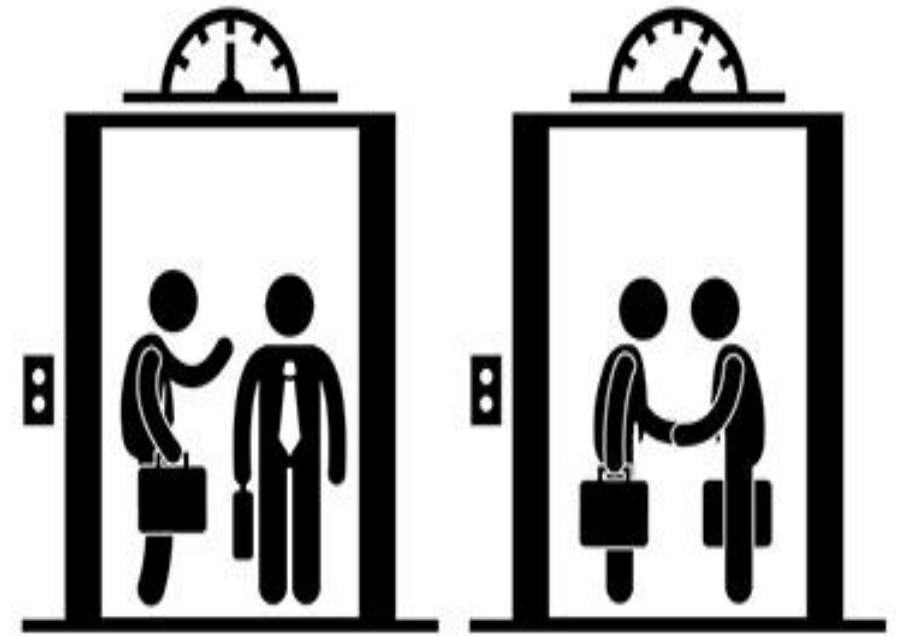


# Standards Activity
